The Henika District Library is governed by a board of trustees. The Board consists of (8) eight members, (4) four residents appointed by the City of Wayland and (4) four residents appointed by the Township of Wayland. The term of appointment is for (4) four years with staggered end dates, unless a seat becomes vacant mid-term in which case the newly appointed trustee will finish the remainder of the term. Trustees are eligible for re-appointment at the discretion of their appointing municipality. The appointed positions are unpaid.

The Library Board adopts the policies that govern the library and handles the financial oversight. The community entrusts the library's wellbeing to the board and expects the board to keep the library running correctly and to ensure that the best possible services are provided. The Board also has the responsibility to see that adequate funding is secured and maintained. The Henika District Library Board of Trustees meets regularly once a month, unless a special meeting is called. Dates and times are determined annually. Currently, the Board meets on the second Tuesday of the month at 6:30pm at the Library. Meetings are open to the public.
